## GAME KING: TRIPLE DOUBLE BONUS VIDEO POKER



**Hot Take:** I used to fucking hate this game. I thought it was for losers who didn't understand the game and odds. After getting my ass handed to me enough times in Double Double and Bonus Poker, I realize now this is the game you turn to when you are just not winning in any other video poker game. She will give you home runs or she will put you out of your misery.

**Overall:** This game traditionally provides larger wins, when it does hit; however, if you are consistently hitting Three of a Kind on this game, you will find yourself out of money fast AF. Play this game for Home Runs and Hail Marys.

**Pros:** 4 Aces w kicker pays the same as the Royal, 2s,3s,4s w kicker pays half the Royal

**Cons:** Getting three of a kind is heartbreaking as they payout 2:1. It will also break your wallet if that's all you are hitting on that machine.
